Applying for a Trade Stand

If you have not exhibited at the show before please contact us with full details of your products and the type and size of stand that you require before completing the application form. If you are a new exhibitor to Southport Flower Show you must enclose or attach a photograph of your stand to your application.

Trade Stand Locations

There are three main trade stand locations: -

- Plants and garden products (shaded green on the show layout)
- General trade stand areas (shaded yellow on the show layout)
- Food village (shaded red on the show layout). Please note that we already have catering contracts in
 place for the consumption of food and drink on site. If you wish to sell food or drink at the show it must
 be packaged for consumption OFF SITE ONLY and you will need to complete either the FOOD TRADE
 STAND APPLICATION FORM or the CONFECTIONARY STAND APPLICATION FORM

Type of Stand

When applying for a stand please note that the size of stand you choose must be large enough to accommodate your exhibit, your sales area and any storage space that you require. During the show the actual size of your stand will be checked against your application form to ensure that all exhibitors comply with the General Conditions of Attendance which can be found in the Exhibitor's Handbook which is available on the Southport Flower Show website. Bespoke stands can only be booked following a conversation and agreement with the Flower Show.

There are four types of trade stands available

- Open stand a defined area marked out on the grass for you to bring in a mobile unit, purpose built
 display or your own marquee to cover all or part of the space or to just use the space as an open display
 stand. Your marquee must be of commercial quality, in good condition, clean and fit for purpose.
- Covered stand a commercial marquee arranged by Southport Flower Show set on grass and comprising
 a roof and four walls, the front of which can be opened fully to the public. The marquee is self-contained
 and has no floor or internal fittings, however these are available as an optional extra. A banner rail and
 sign board is included within the cost of the stand. Images of our covered stands can be found on our

- Food marquee a defined area located internally within a floored marquee. Please see the Food Trade Stand Application Form
- Horticultural display stand a defined area on grass with a marquee covering the rear of the space. The front area is defined with picket fencing. We also supply a banner rail and sign board included within the cost of the stand. The horticultural display stands have been designed with nurseries, growers, garden centres, bulb and plant sellers in mind, to promote good quality, home grown and unusual plants. Exhibitors should create an attractive display at the front of the stand to promote their products in the best possible way. The plants in your display area must reflect the plants that you are selling and an effort must be made to create an interesting and attractive display for visitors whilst providing an improved retail experience through correct labelling and approachable and informative sales advice. Selling from the display area is permitted however the display should remain stocked and to a high standard at all times throughout the show. Should you sell out of your own stock any plants that you bring must be of the same quality and price and not cheap or of inferior quality. No Danish trolleys or other bulk storage units are allowed in the display area and the storage of trolleys is strictly limited to the covered part of your stand. Horticultural display stands will automatically be eligible for judging.

Trade Exhibitors Passes

Below are details of the different passes, their function and how many are allocated per stand. If you require additional passes these can be purchased using the form on page 3 of the Trade Stand Application Form - all tickets include VAT at the current rate.

Please note that if you have lost or mislaid your passes <u>for any reason</u> and you need a replacement you will be charged.

Exhibitor's Build Up and Breakdown Passes

This pass will allow vehicle access to the site before the show for build-up, during the show at specified times to allow for re-stocking, and after the show for the break down. Each vehicle requiring access must have a pass and they are non-transferable between vehicles. All the details requested on the pass must be completed clearly and the pass must be affixed to the top of the windscreen on the passenger side of the vehicle.

The build-up and breakdown passes will be dispatched to you approximately one month before the show.

If your vehicle does not show a pass or some of the details are not completed this will result in you being delayed at the gate and possibly denied entry.

Exhibitor's Car Park Pass

This allows one vehicle to be parked in the trader's car park before, during and after the show. Passes must be clearly visible at all times and are not transferrable.

Exhibitor's Pass

The Exhibitor's pass allows access to the site during the four days of the show. Each stand will receive an allocated number of passes. For larger stands we will authorise extra passes at no additional charge and a limited number of additional passes can be purchased, please see below.

Water

Access to water is available at various stand pipes situated across the show. Alternatively, if you specifically require a water connection for your site please add this as an additional requirement to your trade stand application. There will be a charge of £120.00 (inclusive of vat) for this service.

Campsite

The campsite facility for the 2017 show will be confirmed shortly. Should you require further information in the meantime please contact the Flower Show office.

Porters

A portering service will be available to visitors, the contact details of which will be made available at the Show.

Trade Stand Competitions

If you would like your stand to be judged in the trade stand competition please read the notes below carefully as we have made some changes for 2017. All trade stands will be eligible to be judged in the trade stand competition, please tick the box on page 2 of the trade stand booking form if you would like your stand to be entered into the competition.

Horticultural Display Stands

One overall winner will be chosen. The winner will receive a £500 reduction on the cost of their stand for 2018, a bottle of Champagne and a medal card.

Non Horticultural Display Stands

This category will incorporate any stand which is not a Horticultural Display Stand so, for example, this may include other plant exhibitors, garden tools, products, clothing and so on. The winner will receive a medal card and a bottle of champagne.

Food Trade Stands

This category will incorporate any trade stand selling food or drink for consumption off site. The winner will receive a medal card and a bottle of champagne.

Judging Criteria

Points will be awarded on a scale of 1 – 10 and the areas that the judging will cover are:- the overall initial impact of the stand, the appeal of the display area, the quality of the products on display, the clarity of the labelling and information available to customers, the arrangement and tidiness of the sales area and the knowledge and helpfulness of the sales staff. If possible we would like your stand to incorporate either a floral element to reflect the nature of the show or a feature reflecting the show theme, which for 2017 is **The Curious Garden.** There will be 3 judges appointed by Southport Flower Show with skills in horticulture, food and retail who will judge the stands and the awards will be made no later than the Friday of the show at the winning stands.

Show Theme

Each year the chosen theme is reflected throughout the showground in displays and also within the various competitive areas such as the Grand Floral Marquee, Floral Arts and the Show Gardens. Although not obliged to do so, trade exhibitors are welcome to incorporate the theme into their display if they wish.

Exhibitors expecting to work outside of these hours must make prior arrangements by contacting the Flower Show office.

Deliveries

All deliveries arriving on site must have a contact name, mobile number and stand number. Deliveries will not be allowed on site if contact details are not available. Please make sure that you or a representative is available to accept deliveries.

Show Days

The show will be open to the public during the following times:

Thursday 17th August 10am - 6pm Friday 18th August 10am - 6pm Saturday 19th August 10am - 6pm Sunday 20th August 10am - 5pm

Trade stands **must** be open during the show hours.

Re-stocking

You will be able to have vehicle access to restock your stand:

In the morning from 7am – 9am
In the evening from 6.30pm – 8pm

Break Down

Vehicles will be allowed into the show for the breakdown of your stand as follows:

All Sites Sunday 20^{th} August 6pm Monday 21^{st} August 8am - 6pm Tuesday 22^{nd} August 8am - 4pm

Covered stands must be cleared no later than 11am Monday 21st August. All other stands must be cleared no later than 4pm Tuesday 22nd August.
